### **Submission Guidelines:**

#### **Length of the Manuscripts:**

Manuscripts should be approximately 1500-2000 words

#### **Title /Heading:**

Include the Title of the article, name of the author(s), and institutional mailing address with Phone number with country code and e-mail address.

#### **Abstract:**

A comprehensive and informative abstract of 100-150 words must accompany the manuscript. This abstract should summarize the major points of the paper.

#### **Citation:**

The format of citations, references, and other details should be prepared in accordance with the latest version of publication manual of the American Psychological Association (APA).

#### **Tables and figures:**

Tables and figures should be prepared on separate sheet at the end of the running text. Indicate in the text where they have to be inserted. Number and type captions at the top of each table.(download the TemplateNEPER0

The Manuscript should be accompanied by a letter stating that the article is not published in any other journal.

 Indent the first line of every paragraph.  
 Text should be flushed left

REFERENCES

**References**  
 References start on a new page.  
 Center the word References

**Alphabetical order**  
 Alphabetize references by the author's last name (if there's not author, the first letter of the title)

**Line spacing**  
 Double -space throughout.

**Indentation**  
 The first line of every entry is flushed left. Subsequent lines are indented 0.5" (or five spaces)

# General format for Submission of Research Paper

## TITLE PAGE

Use 12 – point Times New Roman font.

Centre and double space the title of your paper, your name, as well as the College Name

**Running head: SHORT TITLE 1**

Full version of your Paper's Title

Your Name

College/University

Insert **Page Numbers** in the upper right corner

Flushed left, the words "**Running head**" should only appear on the title page. After a colon, put in a **short version of your paper's title in caps.**

The **Short version of your paper's title should appear on all subsequent pages** (but the words running head show up only on the title page)

**Centre** the word **Abstract**

**Do not indent the first line**

Do not exceed **250 words**
